

Police levy renewal approved in Jamestown

JAMESTOWN — Jamestown voters approved a renewal 3.5 mill levy with an unofficial vote of 343 to 160 in Tuesday's election, according to Greene County Board of Elections. When the polls closed, 68.19 percent of registered voters had chosen to approve the renewal.

The renewal levy, listed as Issue 10 on the ballot, generates \$93,000 annually for police services.

The approved levy comes as a five-year measure and will provide funds for the Jamestown Police Department.

Fiscal Officer Marsha Haines said Jamestown is a 24/7 police department and provides all-day security for the three schools in the Greeneview school district.

The owner of a \$100,000 home pays approximately \$107 per year, under the levy there will be no increase in cost for residents.
