Police levy renewal on Jamestown's ballot

JAMESTOWN — Jamestown voters will have the renewal of Issue 10 on the ballot Nov. 4. The 3.5 mill levy generates \$93,000 annually for police services.

If approved, the levy will renew the measure for five years and would provide funds for the Jamestown Police Department.

Fiscal Officer Marsha Haines said Jamestown is a 24/7 police department and provides all-day security for the three schools in the Greeneview school district.

The owner of a \$100,000 home pays approximately \$107 per year, under the levy there will be no increase in cost for residents.
